APTOS, CA – Cabrillo College today announces that it has extended the application deadline to August 5 for new committee members applying to serve on the Cabrillo College Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee. The college is accepting applications for three committee representatives: 1) an active member of a senior citizens' organization, 2) an active member of a college support organization, and 3) a member of a student organization or club. Oversight committee members cannot be employees, officials, vendors, consultants or contractors of Cabrillo College.
