Cabrillo College to Host Free DACA Renewal Clinics at its Watsonville and Aptos Campus Locations

Clinics Held in Watsonville Thursday, March 9 and in Aptos Wednesday, March 15

APTOS – In partnership with the Santa Cruz Immigration Project, Cabrillo College today announces that it will host two, free Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) Renewal Clinics at both its Watsonville and Aptos campus locations.

The Watsonville DACA Renewal Clinic will be held Thursday, March 9, from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. in Room C-105 of the Solari Green Technology Building, 318 Union Street, Watsonville. The Aptos DACA Renewal Clinic will be held Wednesday, March 15, from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m. in Room 1096 of the Aptos Campus, 6500 Soquel Drive, Aptos.

DACA, or Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals, allows certain undocumented immigrants who entered the United States as minors to receive a renewable, two-year period of deferred action from deportation and eligibility for a work permit.

Certified representatives from the Santa Cruz County Immigration Project will be present to assist individuals with submitting their DACA renewal applications, and representatives from the Santa Cruz Community Credit Union will be on hand to provide information about and assistance with loans to cover DACA renewal fees.

Those attending the DACA Renewal Clinics should bring the following:

- Employment Authorization Card
- Social Security number
- Approval notice
- 2 Passport-size pictures (2"x2")
- Copy of your DACA application that you submitted 2 years ago
