For CSU:

Completion of a minimum of 30 units taken from Areas 1 through 5 Must include completion of Areas 1 and 2 (English and Math & Comm Studies)

2. Certificate of Achievement in CSU General Education/ Breadth Requirements:

Completion of a minimum of 30 units taken from Areas A through E Must include all of Area A (English Language Communication and Critical Thinking) and Area B4 (Quantitative Reasoning)
