

WORK EXPERIENCE AND INTERNSHIPS

Cooperative Work Experience Education (CWEE) provides students with college credit for on-the-job experience that meets the learning objectives developed with a Cabrillo faculty member and a job supervisor. One unit of credit is earned for 60 hours of unpaid work experience or 75 hours of paid work experience. Students may take up to four credit units of work experience in any given semester until the maximum allowable units have been earned.

Students must attend CWEE orientation in order to enroll for a CWEE course. The CWEE orientation schedule and information regarding work experience and internships can be found by visiting the website at:

General Work Experience Education – CWEE 99G

For students who wish to enroll in work experience not aligned with a specific program degree or certificate. General Work Experience units are transferrable to the CSU system.

Occupational Work Experience – CWEE 199C

For students who wish to enroll in work experience aligned with a specific program degree or certificate. Occupational Work Experience units are non-transferable. College programs that offer Occupational Work Experience as an elective or requirement include:
