

ENGLISH

Computerized prerequisite verification is required to enroll in English. A minimum grade of "C" or "Pass" is required in the prerequisite course.

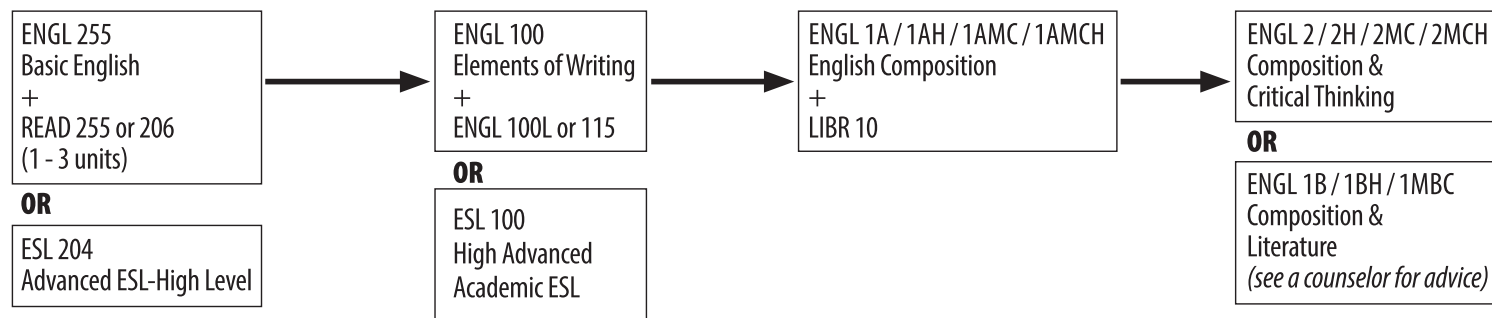
ENGL 14C Screenwriting Workshop
