

Cooperative Work Experience Education (CWEE)

Cooperative Work Experience Education (CWEE) provides students with college credit for on-the-job experience that meets the learning objectives developed with a Cabrillo faculty member and a job supervisor. One unit of credit is earned for 60 hours of unpaid work experience or 75 hours of paid work experience. Students may take up to four credit units of work experience in any given semester.
