- Completion of or concurrent enrollment in Psych 1 or Soc 1 is required for Psych 2A.
- CSU campuses typically require statistics only (Math 12 or Psych 2A) for psychology majors.
- Many campuses require math in addition to statistics; specific math requirements will be found on ASSIST, but often include Math 18 or Math 4 or Math 5A.
- Math 112 not recommended given other math courses that are sometimes required. Math 152 is the recommended path.

The math pathways presented are recommendations. In the case of some majors, other math options are available. For transfer students, math courses should be selected based on the lower-division major preparation requirements at the intended transfer university. Those specific requirements can be found at www.assist.org for 4-year public institutions in California. Please see a counselor for advisement to ensure you are taking the best possible courses given your goal.
