

## **Cabrillo Extension: Kimono Workshop**

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Dear Students,

This Kimono is based on the traditional kimono made of 5 rectangles. Since you will choose your desired length of the Kimono and fabrics come in different widths, please consider this when choosing the amount of fabric to bring. If you are using fabric with a width of 54" to 60", I suggest 1 1/2 to 2 yards for above the knee to knee length and 2 1/2 to 3 yards for longer. If you are using a fabric with a width of 44/45", you will need 2 1/2 to 3 1/2 for the project. Fabric Options: Silk, Rayon, Polys, lightweight cotton. My favorite fabric for the project is rayon. NO KNITS!!!

There are several Sewing Machines to use in the classroom but feel free to bring your own sewing machine for the class.

### **Materials List:**

- Fabric: 1 1/2 to 3 yards depending on length. No Knits!
- thread for project
- measuring tape/grid ruler
- pins or fabric clips
- scissors
- fabric marking tool
- seam ripper
