Thank you so much for signing up for the upcoming Shibori Workshop! It is sure to be a day full of creativity and I am looking forward to making some beautiful projects together. For this workshop all students will be making a set of two 20 inch square cotton throw pillow covers. The dye process can be a bit messy, so please bring an apron or wear something you don't mind getting splashed with indigo.

We will likely have a bit of time for everyone to dye an additional small item if you'd like to bring something with you. Some good projects are bandanas, shirts, baby onesies, kitchen towels (without too much texture), pillowcases, or anything around that size. Indigo is a unique type of dye that bonds to material on a molecular level, so it works only on natural fibers that are plant or animal based including cotton, linen, silk, bamboo, and wool. Please make sure your item is made from one of these materials as any synthetic fabric will not turn out.
