

Dear Students,

Here is some important information for our Day Hike in Davenport:

Schedule and Meeting location

Carpool at 10 a.m. sharp from Cabrillo's parking lot L, 6500 Soquel Drive, Aptos. One day parking permits (\$4.00) are available at self-serve kiosks located in the parking lots, and may be purchased using credit/debit cards only. Note: It is 35 miles one-way from Cabrillo College to the Chalk Mountain trailhead with a short portion of our drive being on a dusty country road.

Equipment

The following is a general list of items for you to consider:

- Footwear that is comfortable and suitable for hiking.
- A day pack that is large enough to carry extra layers of clothing, food, sun screen, and water.
- If you plan on swimming or wading in the ocean (time permitting) then you might consider bringing a swimsuit and water-shoes.

Cell Service

Although service is often available in-route to the trailhead, there will be absolutely no service on Chalk Mountain.

Weather

Fog can roll in at any time thus dropping the temperature quickly. If you bring layers then you will be prepared for most weather conditions. Click [HERE](#) to see the National Weather Service Forecast for the area that we will be hiking in.

Chalk Mountain Travel Directions

We highly recommend carpooling from Cabrillo College (see above) in a caravan formation given the trailhead is difficult to find. Here are directions should you decide to drive: Highway 1 North to Whitehouse Canyon Road. Note: It is 35 miles one-way from Cabrillo College to the Chalk Mountain trailhead with a short portion of our drive being on a dusty country road.
