As we prepare for this upcoming hands-on papermaking class, I wanted to share a few suggestions for how best to prepare. Here is a comprehensive list of materials you might consider bringing:

- Recycled paper scraps (printer ink is OK, colored paper scraps, etc)
- Anything small that you would like to embed in hand-made paper such as seeds, dried flower petals, cut-out words from a newspaper or book, natural fiber ribbon, thread or string, fortunes from fortune cookies.
- A plastic bag large enough to fit a small stack of wet 8.5" x 11" paper

We will have two afternoons together. Thus, I recommend you bring:

- Snacks
- Water

Wear clothes you can get messy in, and dress warm as the process can result in your clothes getting wet.
