ACE - Students complete 12 units of coursework in English 1A PLUS, research, and student skills development. The ACE program offers students a pathway to successfully transition into college, build their college skills, and receive support along the way.

STARS - First Year Experience –Stars is a one year academic program that begins in the fall semester. In the first semester students take course work in English 1A PLUS, math, and counseling & guidance in addition to classes for their major or transfer.

BIW- (Business Information Worker) Earn a Business Information Worker certificate in only two semesters, and start your career! Develop expertise in Microsoft Office, business technology, and other high demand skills to be ready to work in any business office.

Math PLUS – FREE one-week intensive math review designed to prepare students for their upcoming math course. Have fun reviewing math with friends, terrific tutors, and amazing instructors!

Puente - Open to students that want to transfer to a four year college or university. Coursework includes English 1A PLUS with a social justice theme. Students work closely with a career-related mentor and a dedicated counselor.
