# Cabrillo baseball falls to host Delta

## Cho leads Seahawks golf in conference tourney

Cabrillo College's baseball team allowed three unearned runs in the bottom of the sixth inning and lost a nonconference game 7-5 to host Delta in Stockton on Tuesday.

Pitcher Cedar Morgan [1-1] took the loss, and the Seahawks had two errors in the game, which was the first of a three-game series.

Cabrillo [8-2] finished with 15 hits. The Seahawks' Nos. 5-7 hitters were a combined 11-for-14 batting, but they were stranded on base a total of seven times.

The Seahawks' Jakob Ohmann was 4-for-5 with two doubles and three runs scored. Anthony Austin was 4-for-4 with four RBIs. Michael Gerlach was 2-for-3.

Cabrillo hosts Delta [9-1] in the second game in the series at 2 p.m. Thursday.
