Cabrillo baseball clobbers Ohlone

Joe Davis and Kevin Hatch each drove in three runs, and Taylor Toccalino pitched five shutout innings as Cabrillo College's baseball team leapfrogged host Ohlone into second place in the Coast Conference Pacific Division standings with its 8-1 win over the defending state champion in Fremont on Saturday.

Davis finished 3-for-4 with a double, a stolen base and a run scored. Hatch had one hit, smacking a three-run home run in the fourth inning off Ohlone starting pitcher Matt Fontaine [5-3].

Matt Horton and Mike Gerlach each had two hits and scored a run for the Seahawks [18-10, 10-6].

Fontaine, an early signee for Fresno State, lasted 6½ innings.

Cabrillo freshman Toccalino [4-3] threw five scoreless innings for the win after escaping bases-loaded jams in the first and fourth innings. Toccalino finished with seven strikeouts and four walks while allowing four hits.

Ohlone's Joel Thys had three hits and Christian Weeber had two.

It was the fifth straight win for the streaking Seahawks, who can earn a series sweep of Ohlone [14-12, 9-6] on Thursday in Aptos. Cabrillo also hosts West Valley [13-13, 7-6] on Tuesday. Both games start at 2:30 p.m.
