Cabrillo's Tapiz qualifies for state

Seahawks' Baade places third at conference meet

Cabrillo College swimmer Nate Tapiz won the 200-yard backstroke at the Coast Conference Championships at Ohlone College on Saturday, qualifying for next week's state title meet.

Tapiz, an Aptos High alum, claimed the conference title in 1 minute, 58.24 seconds and will compete in both the 200 and 100 back events at the state championships at College of East Los Angeles starting Thursday.

Cody Gilbert, another Aptos High grad, took fourth in the 200 butterfly [2:01.83] and Tyler Fox made the final heat in the same event, taking eighth [2:22.34]. The Seahawks were fifth as a team with 387 points; Foothill won the meet with 615.

WOMEN'S SWIMMING

Adriane Baade placed third in the 200 freestyle, helping Cabrillo take fourth in the Coast Conference Championships at Ohlone College.

Baade swam a time of 57.17. Heather Mallowney was fifth in the 100 back in 1:07.69. Cabrillo finished with 418 points and winner San Mateo finished with 608.
