Seahawks LeFever, King honored

Cabrillo College softball players Bianca King and Sarah LeFever headlined the Seahawks' picks to the All-Coast Conference team, which was decided by coaches at the postseason meeting in San Jose on Thursday.

LeFever, a shortstop, was named to the first team, earning her spot with a .418 batting average as one of the top three hitters in conference. The Aptos High alumna had 19 RBIs and 12 extra-base hits with four home runs this season and was also nominated for the all-state team, which will be selected Saturday in San Mateo.

King, who plays second base, also made the first team. She had a .350 batting average and 12 extra-base hits — all home runs.

Pitcher Camille Flores was voted to the second team after earning at least one win against every team in the conference, except champion San Jose City College, which finished the season undefeated. Cabrillo's Sara Ostlund, with a .313 batting average and 25 RBIs, 17 extra-base hits and three home runs was also named to the second team.

Team captain Andi Underwood earned honorable mention for her standout defensive play at third base.
