

CABRILLO VOLLEYBALL **DOMINATES STATE, MAKES** NORCAL PROUD: Coach Gabby Houston Neville made her team watch excerpts of Herb Brooks' speech from the movie "Miracle" every day before the state tournament, and the Seahawks' win was hardly less amazing than the USA hockey team's 1980 Olympics victory over Russia. Cabrillo became the first NorCal team to win the California Community College Athletic Association title in the modern, 36-year history of the tournament, breaking its own streak of first-day losses and finishing an undefeated 31-0, also a NorCal first. It only lost eight sets the entire season.
