CBEST

California Basic Educational Skills Test. All credential candidates must pass math, reading, and writing skills test. Take it as soon as you have completed college requirements in English and math.

CSET

California Subject Examination for Teachers. Assessment on subject matter competency.

RICA

Reading Instruction Competence Assessment. Taken after completion of reading courses in the credential program.



24 units ECE/CD including ECE 31/131, 32/142, 53, 53L and 51 plus 16 GE including Engl 1A or Comm 1 or 2 or 10, Math 154 or higher level or Sci, SS, and Hum. 6 specialization units and 2 adult supervision units 175 days of 3+ hours per day within 4 years

Credential Program not required for Associate Teacher, Teacher and Master Teacher.

6 more semester units in one area of Specializations, and 2 semester units of ECE 157 C (Adult Supervision) with completion of 350 days of experience within the last 4 years.

II ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Recommended to complete an AA-T in Elementary Teacher Education, a Liberal Studies or Child and Adolescent major. Complete a US Constitution course: PS1, HIST17A or exam, plus 50 hours of classroom experience in a public elementary school. Verify subject matter competence passing CSET or complete subject matter program.

B.A., Multiple Subject Credential Program

III MIDDLE SCHOOL

Major in CTC Commission-approved subject-matter program that you plan to teach or achieve a passing score on appropriate CSET subject-matter exam. Complete a US Constitution course: PS1, HIST17A or exam, plus 50 hours of classroom experience in middle school in area of interest.

CBEST, CSET (if applicable)

B.A., Single Subject Credential or Multiple Subject Credential. Plus a supplementary authorization in a subject (to teach in that area)

IV HIGH SCHOOL

Major in CTC Commission-approved subject-matter program that you plan to teach or achieve a passing score on appropriate CSET subject-matter exam. Complete a US Constitution course: PS1, HIST17A or exam, plus 50 hours of classroom experience in a public high school in area of interest.

CBEST, CSET (if applicable)

B.A., Single Subject Credential

V EDUCATION SPECIALIST

Special Education K-12

Major in Liberal Studies, Child Adolescent Development Program or area of interest. Complete a US Constitution course: PS1, HIST17A or exam, plus 50 hours of classroom experience in area of interest in public education program.

CBEST, CSET (if applicable), RICA

B.A., Education Specialist Credential. Pass RICA exam.

VI DESIGNATED SUBJECTS VOCATIONAL EDUCATION TEACHING CREDENTIAL

High School diploma or GED, if working over 15 hours per week, US Constitution or exam.

Verified 3 years of work experience directly related to subject named on credential. Verification by a commission-approved program and CPR.

VII FULL TIME ADULT EDUCATION CREDENTIAL

Same as Designated Vocational Education Teaching Credential Requirements as above plus:

ESL

Major in English and completion of 20 semester units and or 10 upper semester units in one or combination of TESL, TESOL, foreign language, speech, US Constitution course: PS1, HIST17A or exam.

CBEST

B.A., Verified 3 years of work experience directly related to subject named on credential. Verification by a commission-approved program and CPR.

GED

Completion of 20 semester units with at least 3 units in four of the following six areas: English, math, science, social science, fine arts, foreign language, US Constitution course: PS1, HIST17A or exam.

Completion of 20 semester units with at least 3 units in four of the following six areas: English, math, science, social science, fine arts, foreign language, US Constitution course: PS1, HIST17A or exam.
